

### EMPERORS & SOUTH POLE





# GORILLAS OF BWINDI, UGANDA

Abercrombie & Kent 5 days

The gorillas of Uganda's Bwindi Impenetrable National Park are both rare and endangered, so the chance to see them in the wild is a pretty remarkable opportunity. It will take two days to trek through the forest from the Sanctuary Gorilla Forest Camp to the area where four gorilla families reside. The trek is steep and densely forested, but seeing the gorillas play and forage will make it well worthwhile. Back at the camp, you'll sleep in one of eight spacious tents with ensuites.
